## **COMMUNITY INCLUSION MONTH**

Whereas: in 2010, Canada ratified the United Nations' historic Convention on the

Rights of People with Disabilities, which includes Article 19 - Living

Independently and being included in the community; and

Whereas: many people with developmental disabilities face barriers like poverty and

isolation and have trouble finding housing that is safe, affordable and

accessible; and

Whereas: inclusive housing considers the unique needs of all people and helps to build

supportive, accessible and more resilient communities where everyone has

the chance to contribute, belong and feel valued; and

Whereas: Community Inclusion Month is an annual celebration, focusing in 2020 on

inclusive housing and the importance of supporting the inclusion of all British

Columbians; and

Whereas: the City of Prince George is committed to enhancing inclusion, thus ensuring

that persons with developmental disabilities can participate fully in society.

Now therefore, as Mayor of the City of Prince George,

I proclaim **October 2020** as:
